

Some users with IE 8 have trouble with pages while others do not. Microsoft released a new security patch late last week that turns off some settings. A default new install of the IE 8 browser would also have this problem.

If you are using IE 8, follow the instructions below in order to use the TMDSAS site:

Open I8 Browser and go to <https://www.tmdsas.com/>

From the IE8 tool bar, select:

- Tools → Internet Options. (Internet Options pop-up window will appear)
- Click the “Security” tab in the Internet Options pop-up window (see image A).
- In the “Security” tab,
 - click **Trusted Sites**
 - and then the **Site** button (see image A)
- In the “Trusted sites” pop-up window,
 - click the Add button and
 - and then the Close button (see image B)
- In the Security tab (see image A),
 - click Custom Level.
 - A “Security Settings – Trusted Sites Zone” pop-up window will appear (see image C)
- In the “Security Settings – Trusted Sites Zone” pop-up window
 - scroll down to **Scripting**
 - click the “enable” button for **Active Scripting**
 - click the OK button
- Back in the “Security” tab
 - Click the OK button
- Close the browser and restart/reopen your browser window - IE doesn't take changes until after you quit and restart your browser

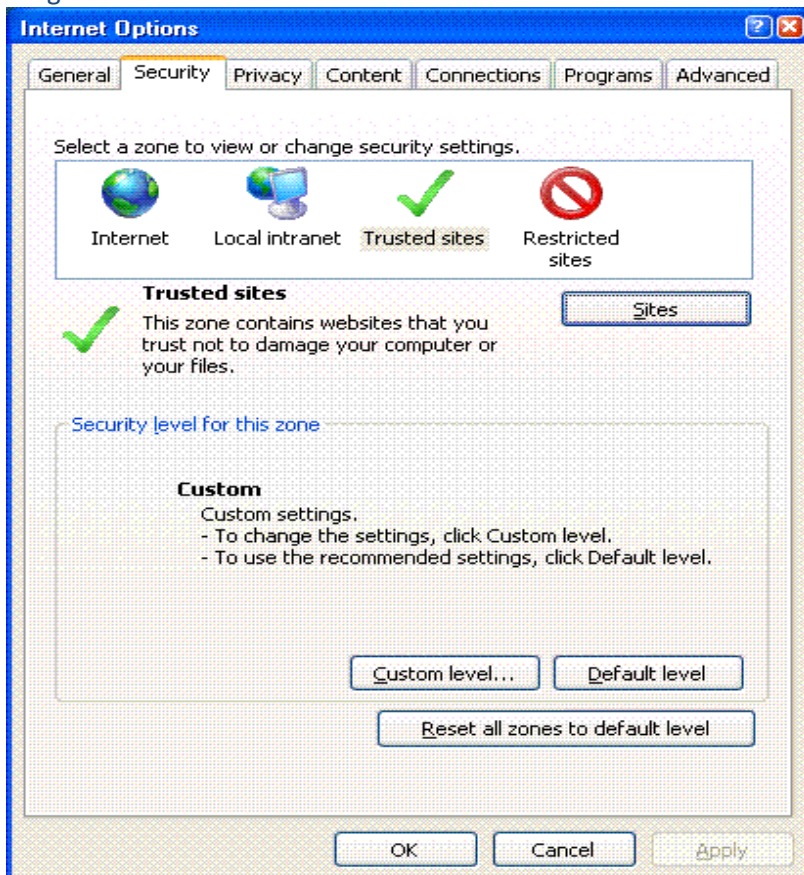
