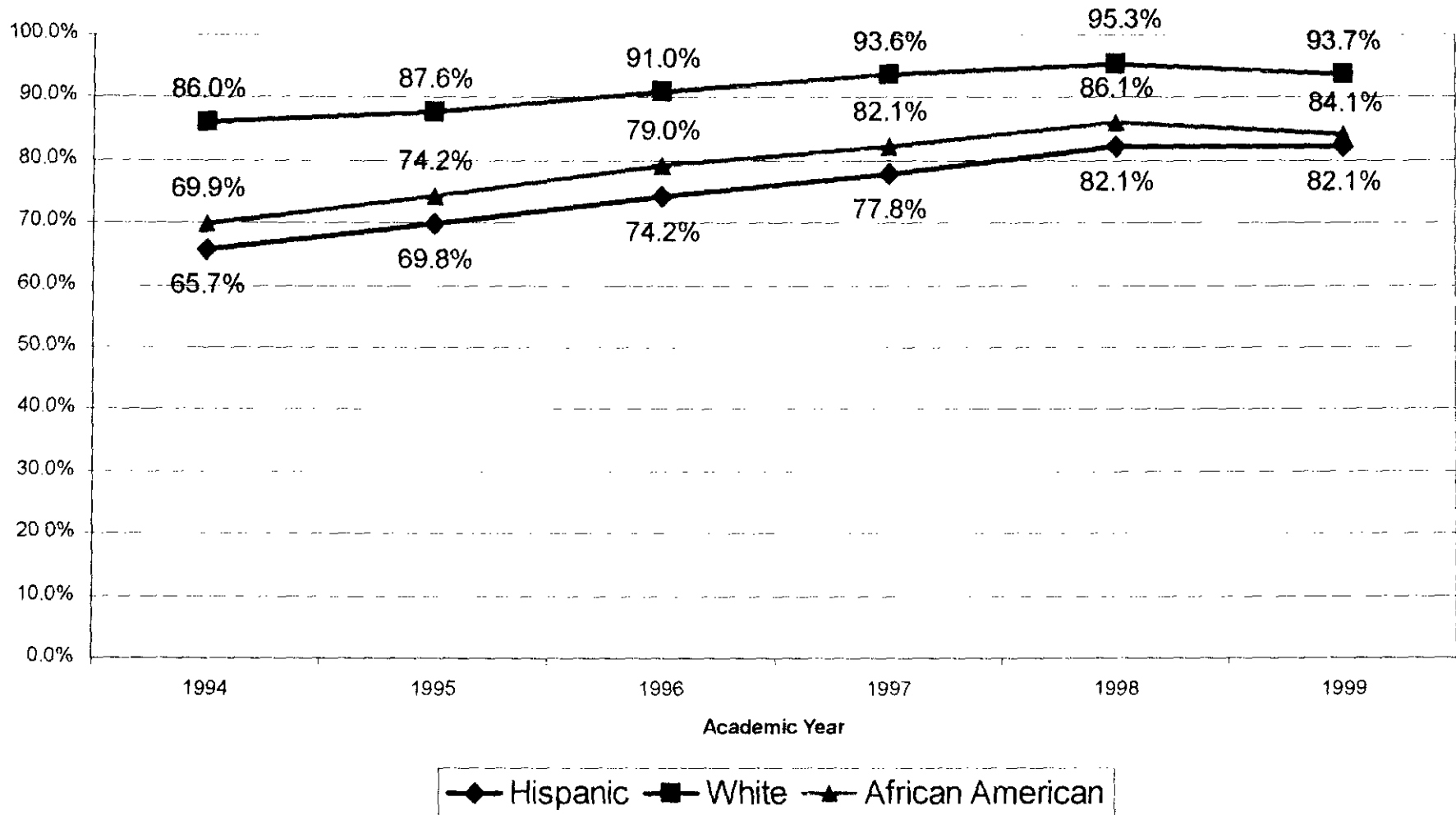

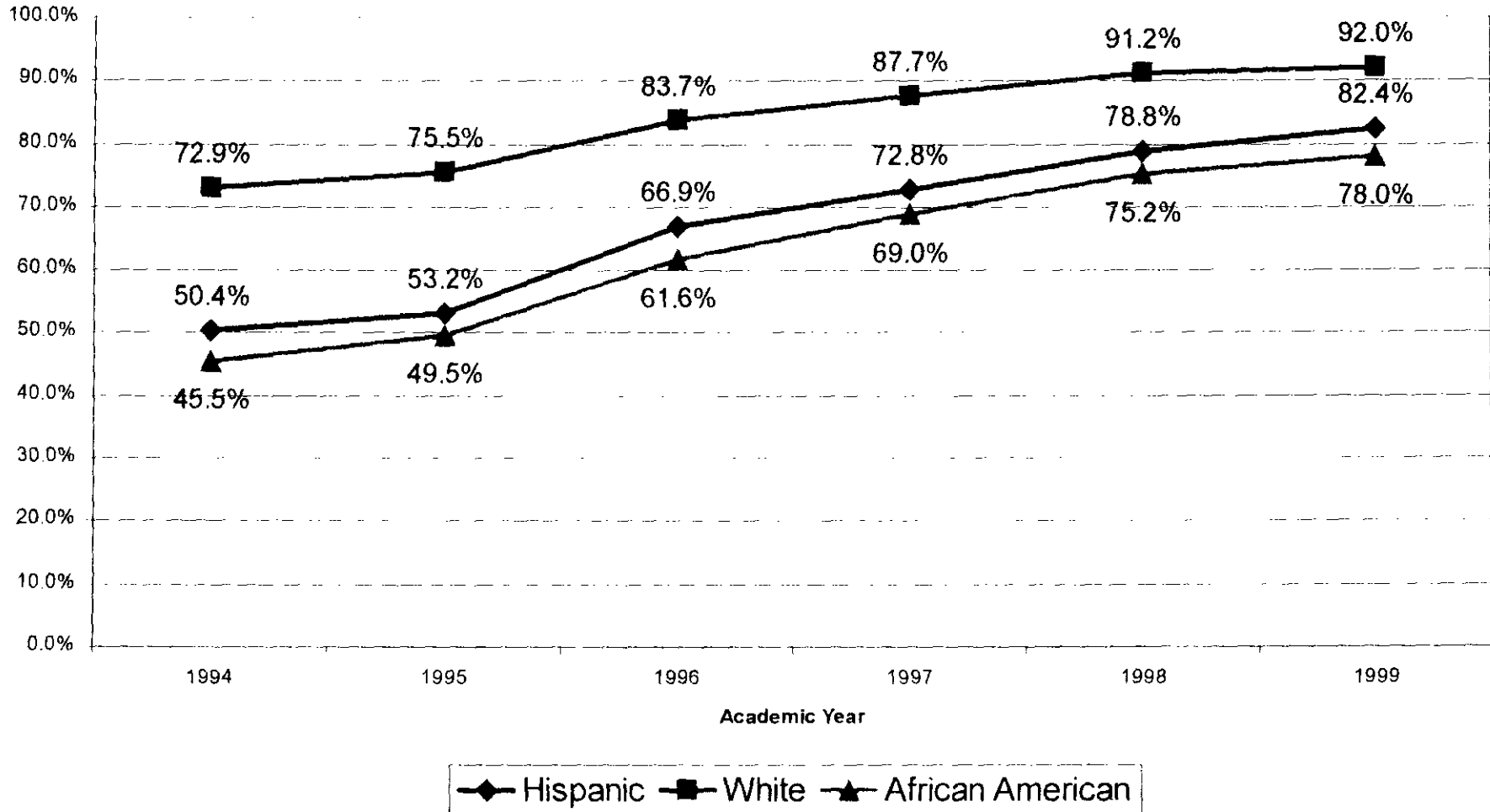

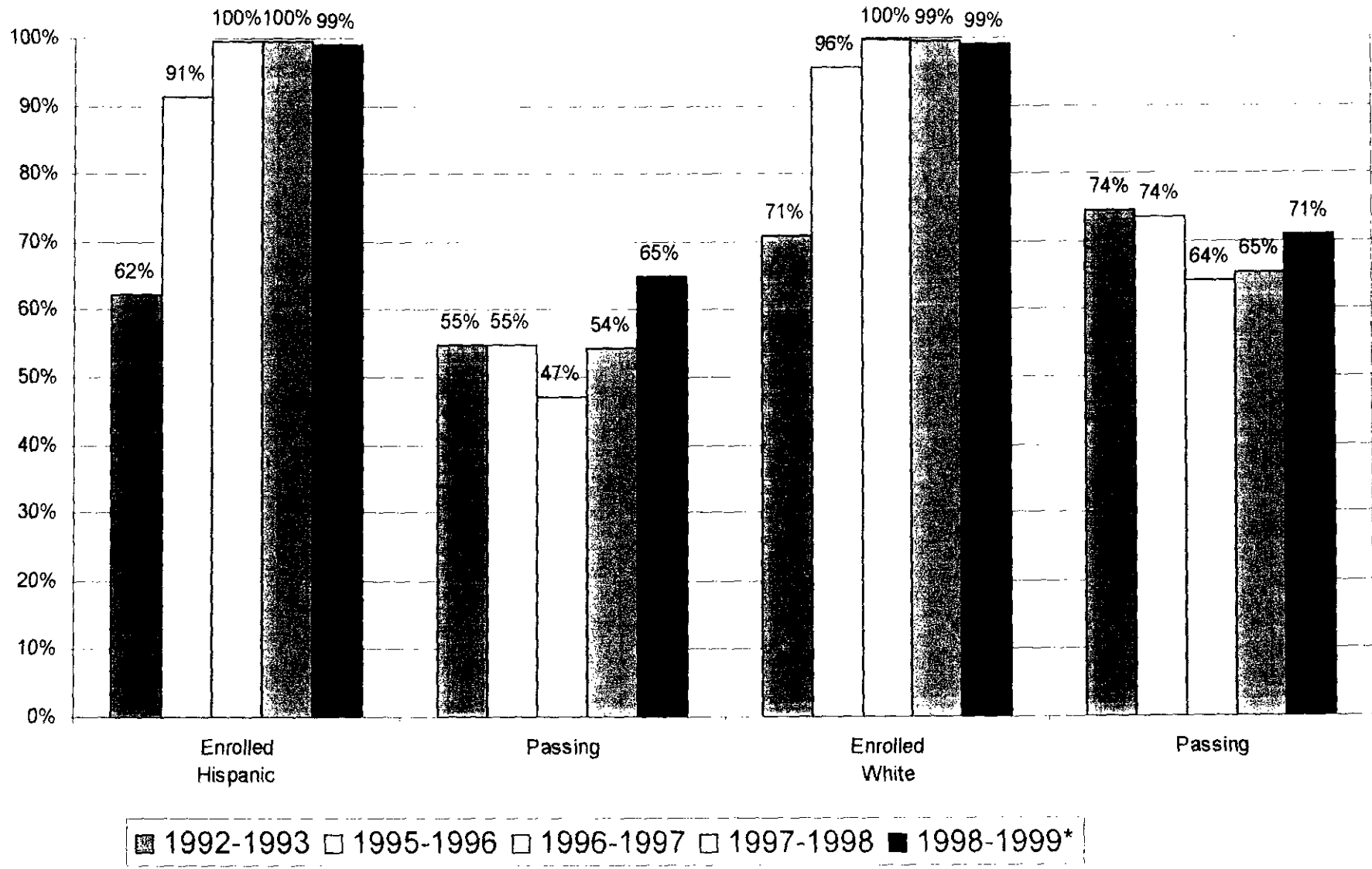

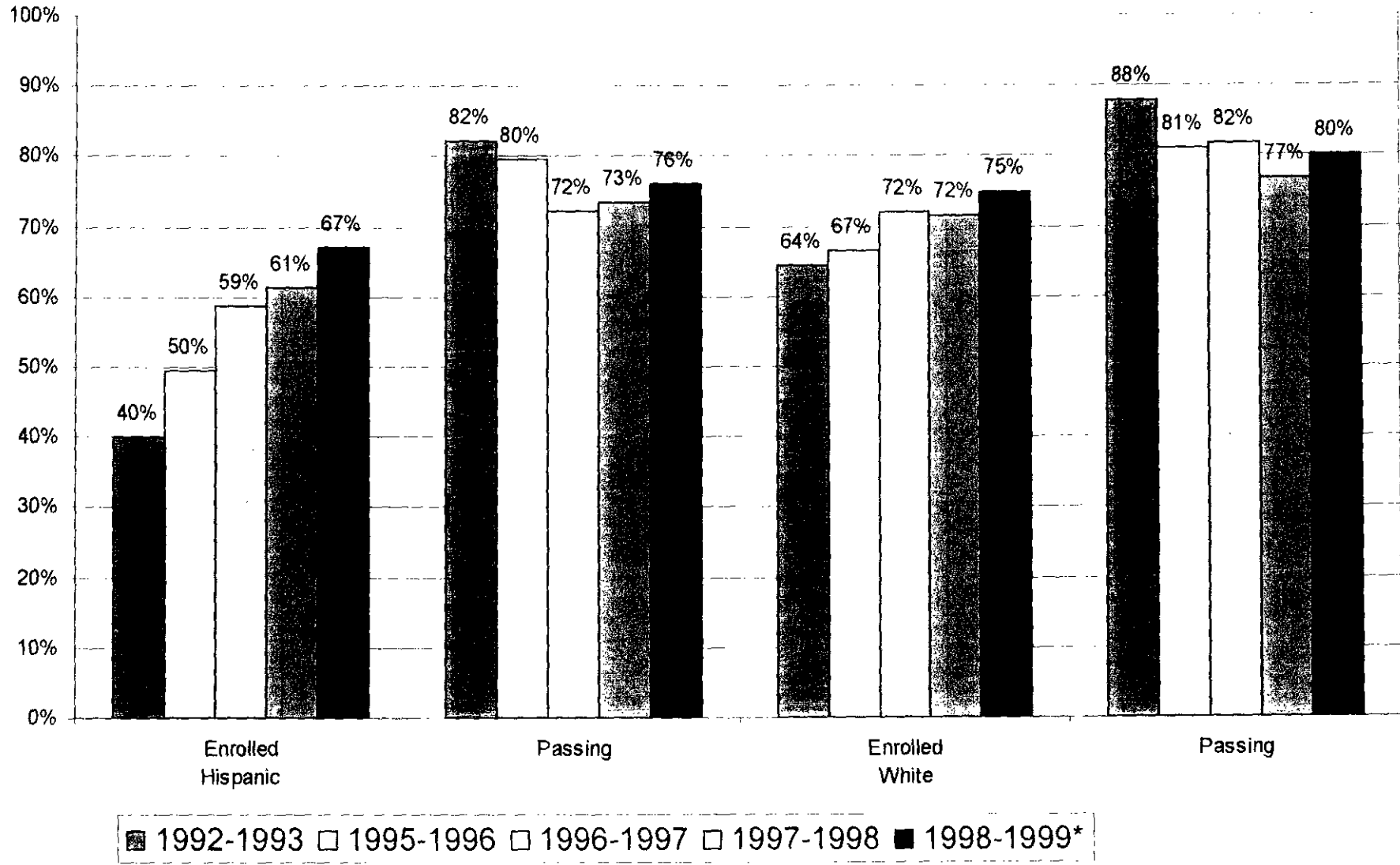

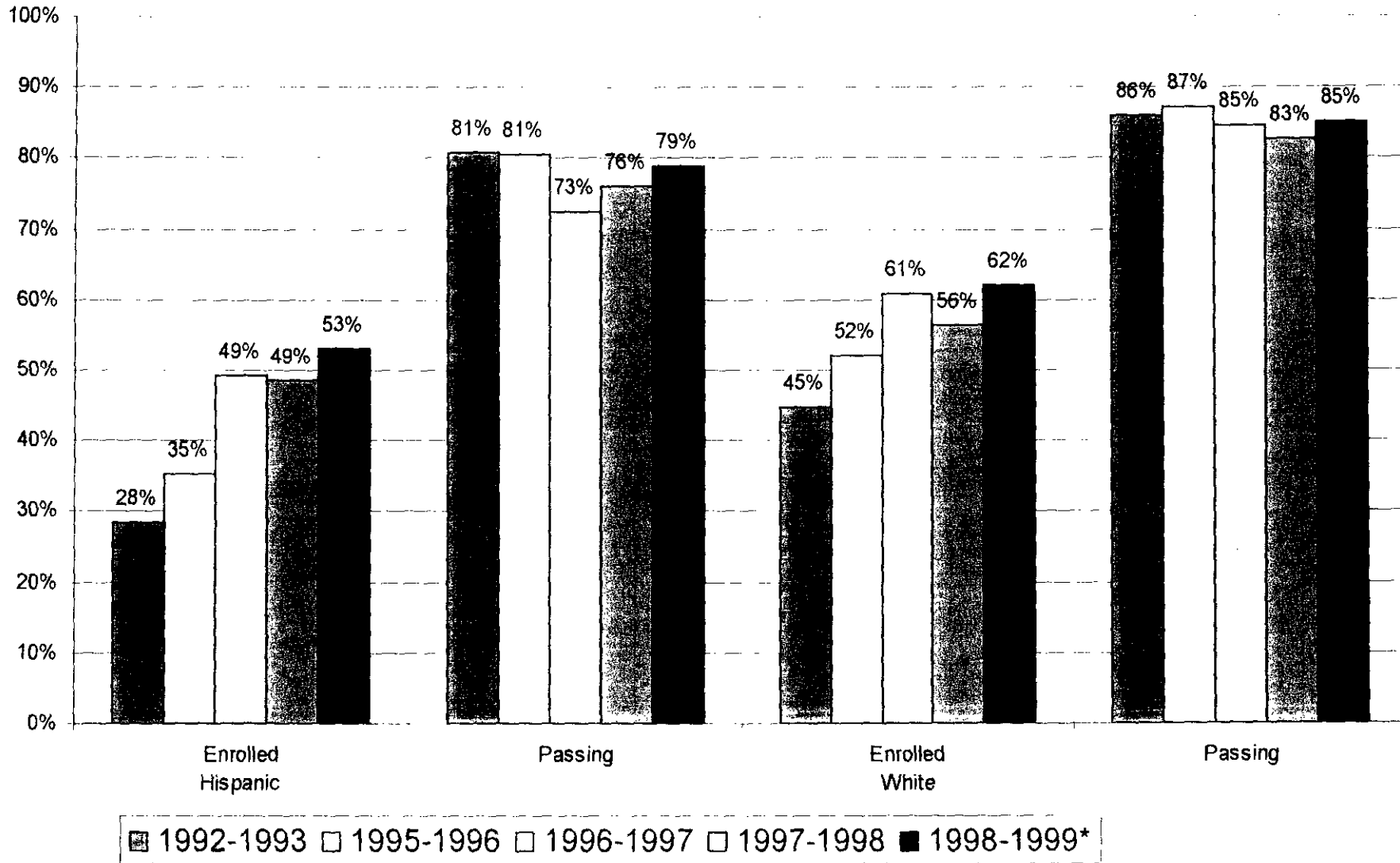
Algebra II Enrollment and Completion by Grade 11

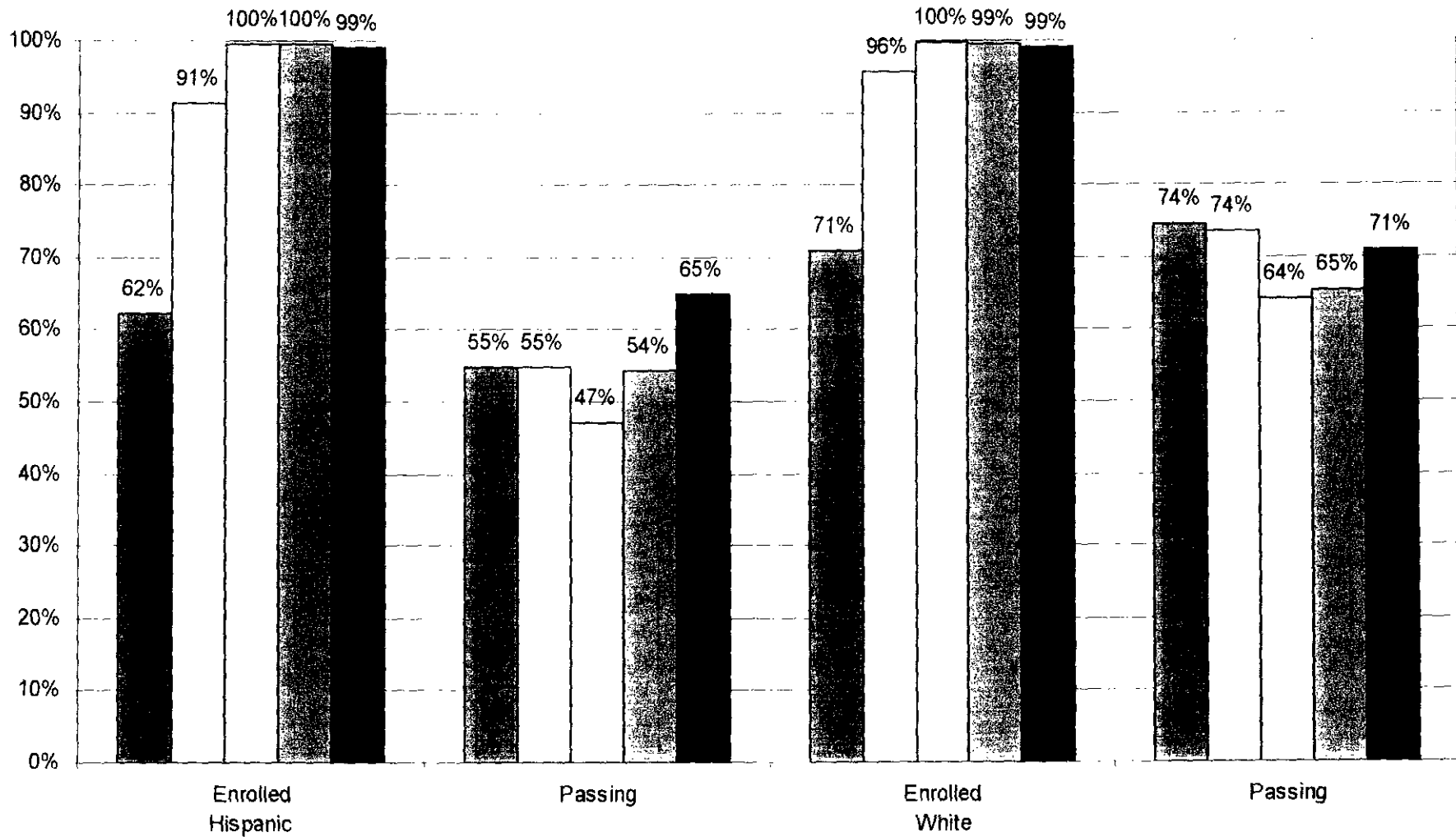

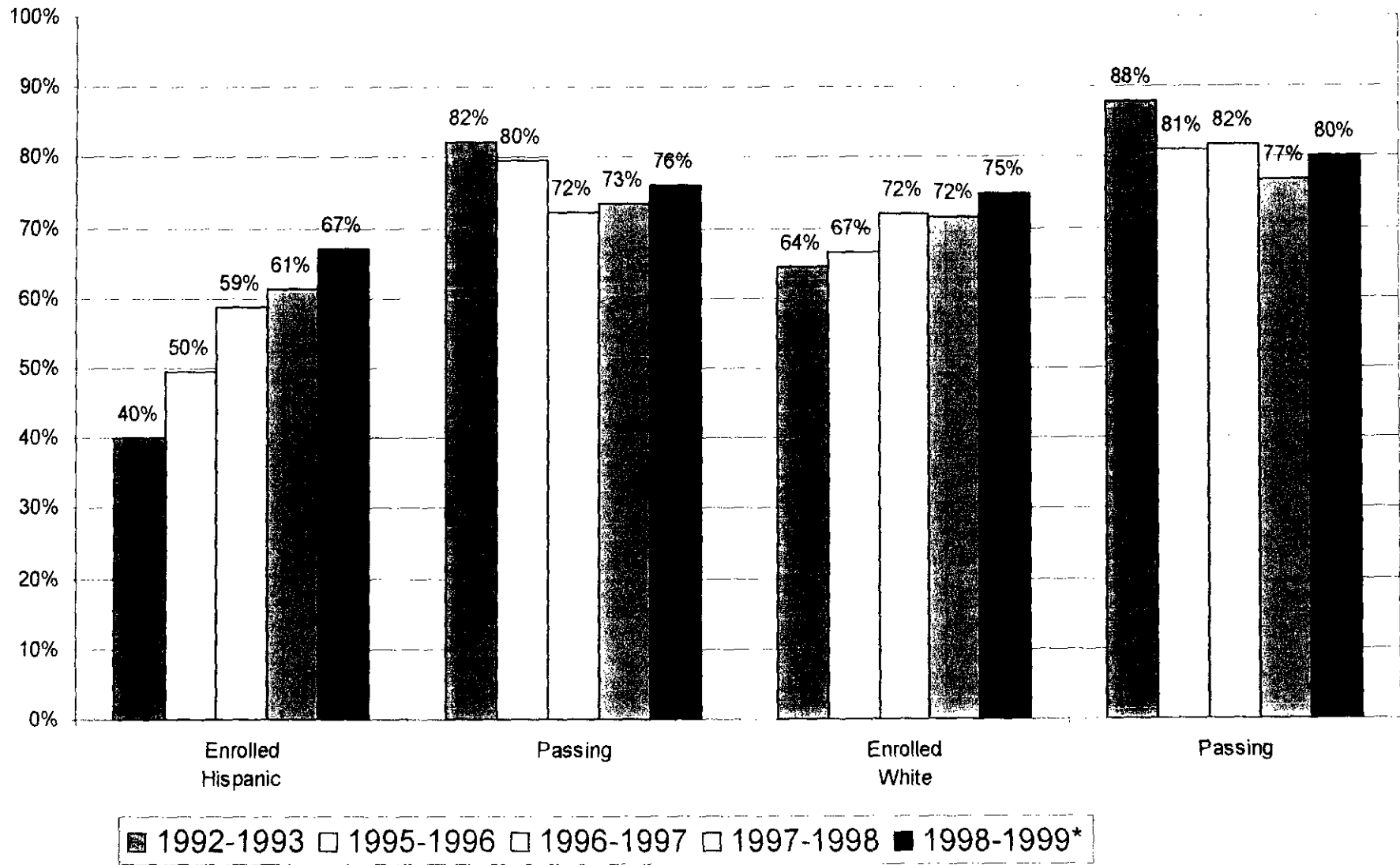
Algebra I Enrollment and Completion by Grade 9
