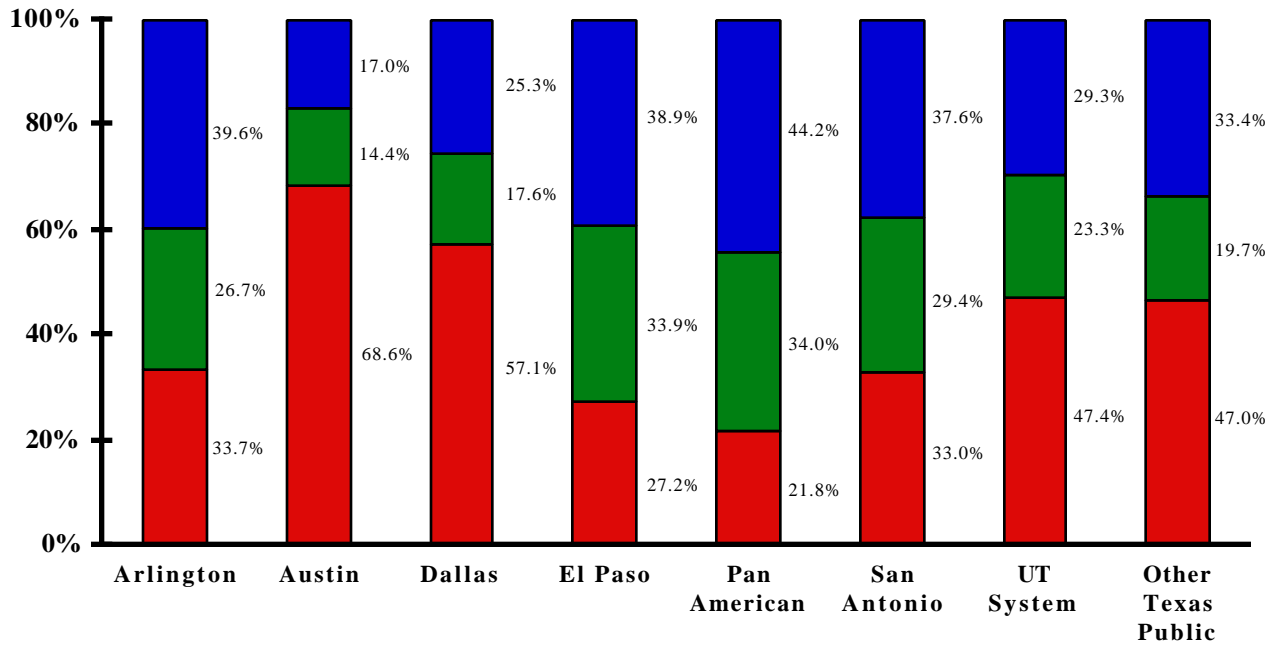


**GRADUATION RATES THROUGH AUGUST 31, 1996

"Graduated" represents students who received a baccalaureate or higher degree from the same or different Texas public institution than they entered as freshmen.

"Still Enrolled" represents students who have not received a baccalaureate or higher degree but were enrolled for at least one semester during the 1995-96 school year in the same or different Texas public institution than they entered as freshmen.

"Not Enrolled" represents students who have not received a baccalaureate or higher degree and were not enrolled for any semester during the 1995-96 school year in the same or different Texas public institution than they entered as freshmen.

"Full-time" means students enrolled in 12 or more semester credit hours.
