 Dr. Leiden received her B.A., M.A. and Ph.D. from the University of Texas at Austin. Dr. Leiden is currently a member of the Secretary's Advisory Committee on Human Research Protections (SACHRP) for the Office of Human Research Protections. She has served as a Council member and site visitor for the Association for the Accreditation of Human Research Protection Programs (AAHRPP). In 2001 Dr. Leiden created the Office of Research Support and Compliance at the University of Texas at Austin. As Director of this office for seven years, she had oversight of research compliance for the University's Institutional Review Board (human subjects' research), Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (animal research) and Institutional Bio-safety Committee. Dr. Leiden has served as the IRB Chair at both The University of Texas at Austin (2005-2007) and the University of Florida (2001). During her tenure at the University of Texas at Austin, she was responsible for the university's successful efforts in obtaining AAHRPP accreditation for their human research protection program. Dr. Leiden has held professional positions in medical education and research at the University of Florida, University of Nevada and the University of Arizona Colleges of Medicine.

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
