

General Analysis – Degrees

System institutions produce over one-third of the degrees and certificates awarded by public universities and almost seven out of ten health care degrees and certificates awarded by health-related institutions in Texas.

In 2005-06, U. T. System institutions awarded 38,282 degrees and certificates, an increase of 8,406 degrees or 28.1% over the 2000-01 academic year.

- The number of degrees and certificates awarded at the academic institutions increased from 27,104 in 2000-01 to 35,243 in 2005-06, a 30.0% increase. Degrees awarded at the master's level are growing at the fastest rate, 34.8%.
- At the health institutions, the number of degrees and certificates awarded increased from 2,772 to 3,039, a 9.6% increase over the same time period.

Overall, around 56.2% of the awards went to women, about the same as the previous year. The growth rate of degrees awarded at health related institutions from 2000-01 to 2005-06, increased for women (by 17.7%) and decreased for men (by -2.6%).

- In 2005-06, women earned 57.0% of baccalaureate degrees at the academic institutions and 73.6% of the certificates and baccalaureate degrees at the health institutions.
- At the graduate/professional level, women earned 51.8% of the awards at academic institutions and 60.3% at health institutions.

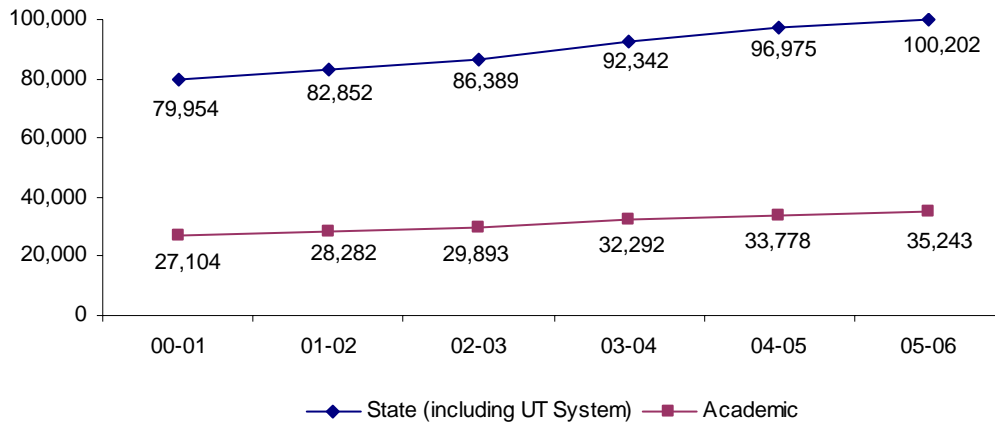
System-wide, the proportion of degrees and certificates awarded to African American, Hispanic, Asian American and International students increased over time, while the proportion awarded to white students decreased. In 2005-06, over half of the awards were to non-white and International students (53.2%), with Hispanics receiving more than one-fourth of the total awards (27.1%).

- At the undergraduate level, non-white and International students earned 53.2% of the degrees at academic institutions and 49.7% of degrees and certificates at the health institutions.
- At the graduate/professional level, non-white and International students earned 55.8% of the degrees and certificates at academic institutions and 40.7% of degrees and certificates at health institutions.

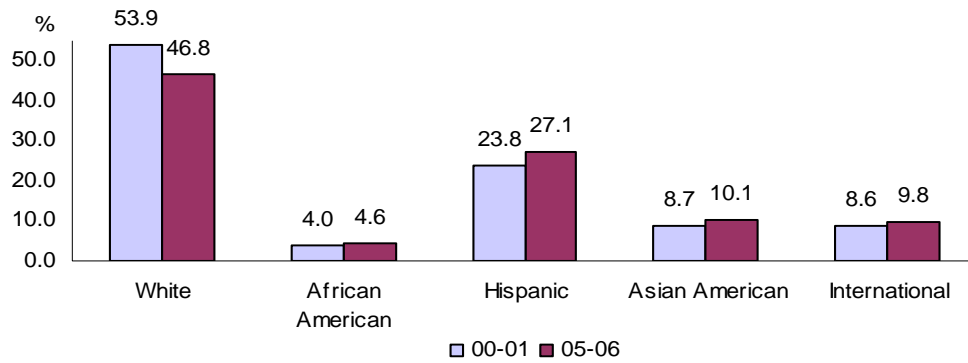
With an increased emphasis nationally in the areas of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM), U. T. System contributed to these degrees at every level. In 2005, 23.8% of baccalaureate, 24.2% of master's and 43.0% of doctoral degrees awarded at U. T. System academic institutions were in a STEM field. Overall, almost one out of four degrees awarded at U. T. System academic institutions was a STEM degree (24.5%), a higher percentage than other public universities in Texas (19.2%) and the nation (19.0%).

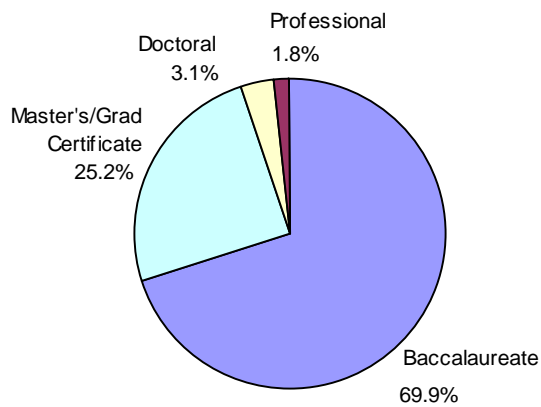
**Total Degrees and Certificates Awarded at U. T. System Academic Institutions and all Texas Public Universities
 AY 2000-01 to 2005-06**



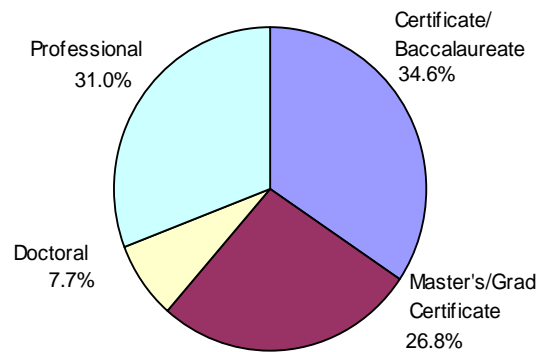
**U. T. System Degrees and Certificates Awarded by Ethnicity
