

## General Analysis – Degrees and Certificates Awarded

System institutions produce over one-third of the degrees and certificates awarded by public universities and over two thirds of health care degrees and certificates awarded by health-related institutions in Texas.

In 2007-08, U. T. System institutions awarded 40,303 degrees and certificates, an increase of 7,710 degrees or 23.7% over the 2002-03 academic year.

- The number of degrees and certificates awarded at the academic institutions increased from 29,893 in 2002-03 to 36,891 in 2007-08, a 23.4% increase. Degrees awarded at the doctoral level grew at the fastest rate, 50.9%.
- At the health institutions, the number of degrees and certificates awarded increased from 2,700 to 3,412, a 26.4% increase over the same time period.

Overall, around 56% of the awards went to women, about the same as the previous year. At the health institutions, the growth rate of degrees and certificates awarded to women was 31.8% from 2002-03 to 2007-08, compared to an 18.2% increase for men.

- In 2007-08, women earned 57.1% of baccalaureate degrees at the academic institutions and 70.9% of the certificates and baccalaureate degrees at the health institutions.
- At the graduate/professional level, women earned 51.0% of the awards at academic institutions and 58.1% at health institutions.

System-wide, the proportion of degrees and certificates awarded to African American, Hispanic, Asian American students increased over time, while the proportion awarded to white students decreased. In 2007-08, over half of the awards were to non-white and International students with Hispanics receiving more than one-fourth of the total awards (29.0%).

- At the undergraduate level, non-white and International students earned 55.0% of the degrees at academic institutions and 43.8% of degrees and certificates at the health institutions.
- At the graduate/professional level, non-white and International students earned 53.4% of the degrees and certificates at academic institutions and 44.1% of degrees and certificates at health institutions.

With an increased emphasis nationally in the areas of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM), U. T. System contributed to these degrees at every level. In 2007, 22.0% of baccalaureate, 21.3% of master's and 48.8% of doctoral degrees awarded at U. T. System academic institutions were in a STEM field. Overall, more than one out of five degrees awarded at U. T. System academic institutions was a STEM degree (22.7%), a higher percentage than other public universities in Texas (18.0%) and the nation (18.5%).

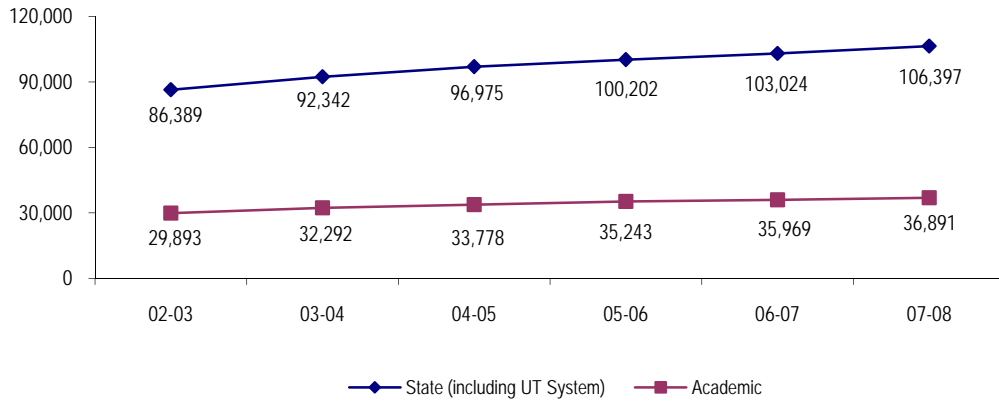
UT System institutions increased the number of health professional degrees to meet growing demands within the state. The number of nursing degrees awarded at the academic and health institutions increased by 35.1%, from 1,566 in 2002-03 to 2,116 in 2007-08.

- At the academic institutions, baccalaureate degrees in nursing increased from 712 to 984 (38.2%) and master's degrees in nursing increased from 144 to 217 (50.7%).
- At the health institutions, baccalaureate degrees in nursing increased from 528 to 612 (15.9%) and master's degrees in nursing increased from 173 to 240 (38.7%).

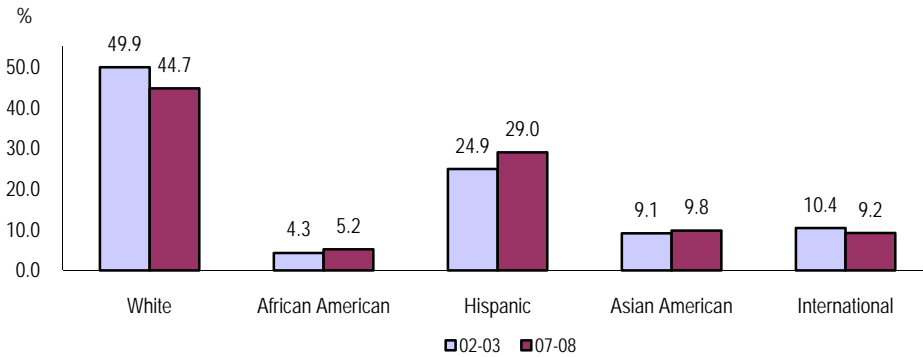
The health institutions also significantly increased the number of degrees in Health Professions, formerly Allied Health, (Master's, by 68.4%) and Biomedical Sciences (Doctoral, by 34.8%) from 2002-03 to 2007-08. The number of professional medical degrees increased from 749 to 804 (7.3%), while the number of professional dental degrees decreased by 8.4%, from 154 to 141 during the same period.

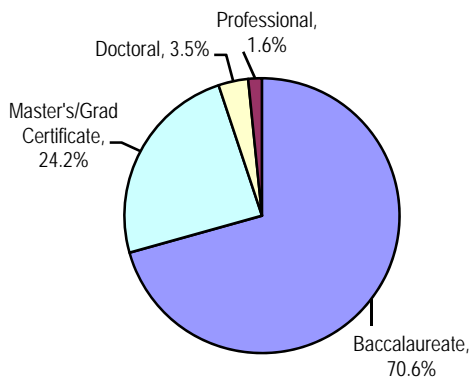
Total Degrees and Certificates Awarded at U. T. System Academic Institutions

 AY 2002-03 to 2007-08



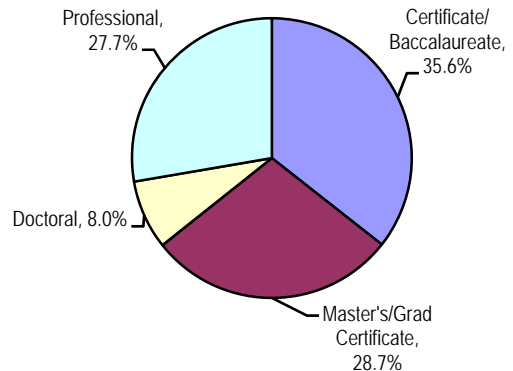
U. T. System Degrees and Certificates
