



Applicant's Supporting Documents

It is the responsibility of the JAMP applicant to meet with his/her JAMP Faculty Director (JFD) prior to starting the application and assist in the collection of the supporting documents.

The following documents are required to be submitted by the JFD and must be received by the JAMP administrative office not later than October 15th for the application to be considered for review.

1. Notice of Intent to Apply and Authorization to Release Records (One Form)
2. High School Transcript and Class Rank
3. SAT/ACT Scores
4. Student Aid Reports (SAR) *:
a. 2009-2010 SAR
b. 2010-2011 SAR
5. JAMP Applicant Evaluation Forms from:
a. JAMP Faculty Director
b. University Faculty
6. College Transcripts (Community or any other Colleges attended)
7. Official University Transcript
