- Advancing Diversity and Equality in Leadership Committee: Presented on the research and data regarding age, gender, and ethnicity disparities across all 14 institutions. The committee will be working on an executive summary and whitepaper.
- Employee Experience Committee: Presented their findings after 100% survey
  participation across all UT Institutions. This will help facilitate communication
  on professional development offerings across all UT Institutions. Deliverables
  will be a survey results report, survey data report given to institution
  representatives with noted themes and potential areas for opportunities.
- One System, One Voice Committee: Sarah Pekar completed Website updates, and a brief review of SharePoint was shared. The communication guide is in the review process and will be shared with the EAC in September. The new EAC newsletter will be ready for the September meeting.
