Series 20204, related to determining and documenting the reasonableness of compensation; commensurate with the responsibilities of the position; and submitted to the Board for approval via the usual budgetary procedures.

Vice Chairman Krier further moved that the Minutes reflect that, by approval of this motion, the Board has made a finding as required by State law that this individual appointment is in the best interest of U. T. Austin.
