



## RISK MANAGEMENT EDUCATION

### The University of Texas System Professional Medical Liability Benefit Plan

All healthcare providers enrolled in the UT System Professional Medical Liability Benefit Plan (Plan) are required to complete five (5) hours of Risk Management Education (RME) each year as a condition of coverage.

To meet this requirement, providers may take online courses provided by UT System or participate in other risk management events and activities. Department coordinators can provide information about these additional activities as well as other institution-specific requirements.

About the online course:

- Med-IQ is the vendor selected by UT System to offer these courses.
- Med-IQ's editorial board members are primarily physicians who are also attorneys.
- Courses use actual cases to teach providers to identify and manage medical-legal risk.
- Credit for each course applies to RME and CME requirements. The amount of credit for each course may vary.
- Any excess credit earned will not roll over into the new year.

To access the courses:

1. Go to [UT.med-iq.net](http://UT.med-iq.net)
2. **Returning Users:** Sign in with your PLI ID or email address and the password you previously used to access your Med-IQ
  - If you cannot remember your password, click the [Forgot your password](#) link to have it reset.

**New Users\*:** If this is your first time accessing Med-IQ, select the **Create an account** link at the top of the page and enter **your unique registration code** that was emailed directly to you.
