An audit of Decentralizing Computing – School of Behavioral and Brain Sciences was conducted as part of the UT Dallas FY25 audit plan. The objective of the audit was to assess the effectiveness of controls over decentralized computing operations in the School of Behavioral and Brain Sciences, including compliance with Texas Administrative Code §202.76 (TAC 202) security control standards, UT System and UTD security and control standards such as vulnerability management (including patching), encryption, third-party applications, IT asset management, IT governance, backup management, and public-facing applications.
