- In 2020, 74\% of all jobs in Colorado - 3 million jobs - will require education beyond high school.
- Colorado ranks 48 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ in available jobs for high school graduates or dropouts.
- Colorado ranks third in the proportion of 2020 jobs that will require a bachelor's degree.
- By 2020, new Colorado jobs requiring postsecondary education and training will grow by 716,000 - compared to only 268,000 new jobs for high school graduates who have no additional training.

- 1 in 3 Colorado $11^{\text {th }}$ graders and graduating seniors take college courses in high school (32\%)
- $85 \%$ of students enrolled in dual enrollment enroll in college
- $43 \%$ of participating school districts have $10 \%$ or fewer high school students participating in concurrent enrollment.
- And $23 \%$ have $5 \%$ or fewer students participating.
