Zain Kazmi serves as Associate Vice Chancellor and Chief Digital & Analytics Officer for Health Affairs at The University of Texas System. In this capacity, he leads enterprise-wide strategic initiatives spanning digital health, technology and EMR optimization, data and artificial intelligence, pharmacy services, patient access, workforce development, and strategy. Working in collaboration with the Chancellor and the UT Health-Related Institutions (HRIs), he is currently guiding the development of the "One UT Health" strategic framework, designed to align and strengthen the system's collective health enterprise. Kazmi is the Executive Sponsor of several high-impact programs, including the UT Health Intelligence Platform (UT-HIP), the UT REAL Health AI program, and the Texas Pharmaceutical Initiative, a statewide effort to reduce the cost of prescription drugs for Texans. He also

manages strategic partnerships with Epic, Vizient, and Microsoft, overseeing health technology strategies with a particular focus on Epic EMR optimization to advance both quality of care and operational performance across the UT System. Nationally recognized for his leadership in digital health and healthcare strategy, Kazmi has been named by Becker's Healthcare as one of the "Chief Digital Officers to Know."

Zain was previously a management consulting executive in Accenture's Digital Health practice. He has extensive experience in developing and formulating thorough analytics strategies and leading implementations across several national and regional Providers and Payers. He was appointed as the Vice Chair of the Board of Directors for International Child Care, a non-profit healthcare system in Haiti and Dominican Republic. He is on the Board of Austin MedTech Connect, an Advisor to the Scottsdale Institute, and a Mentor at the Capital Factory.
