

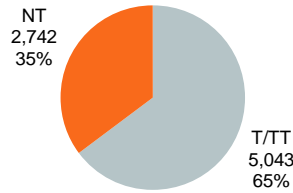
Faculty Teaching at UT System Academic Institutions: AY 2014

Overview of Full-Time Faculty

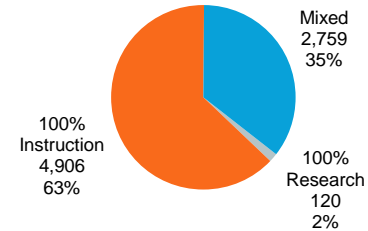
In AY2014 (Fall 2013, Spring and Summer 2014), there were 7,785 full-time faculty at UT System academic institutions.

- 65% were tenured or on tenure-track.
- Less than 2% had an all-research appointment.
- 64% were fully funded by state appropriations.

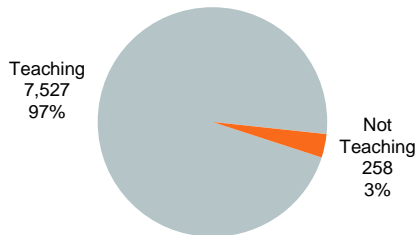

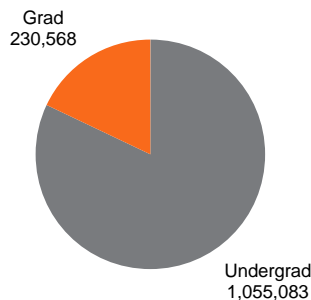


Faculty-Student Interactions

1.3 Million Course Enrollments



All Faculty. 97% of full-time faculty taught in AY2014; 89% taught three or more sections. 7,785 full-time faculty had 1.3 million course enrollments in AY 2014. That is, on average, 165 students to teach for each faculty member per year—30 graduate and 135 undergraduate.

Tenured/Tenure-Track Faculty. 99% of full-time T/TT faculty taught in AY2014; 94% taught three or more sections. Each T/TT faculty member taught, on average, 133 students—32 graduate and 101 undergraduate—last year.

All-Research Faculty. 63% of full-time faculty members with an all-research appointment taught in AY 2014; 27% taught three or more sections. Each of these faculty taught 77 students on average—5 graduate and 72 undergraduate—last year.

Mixed Appointment Faculty (at least some research). 97% of full-time faculty members with a mixed appointment taught in AY2014, and 89% taught three or more sections. 151 students—33 graduate and 118 undergraduate—were taught by each of these faculty last year.

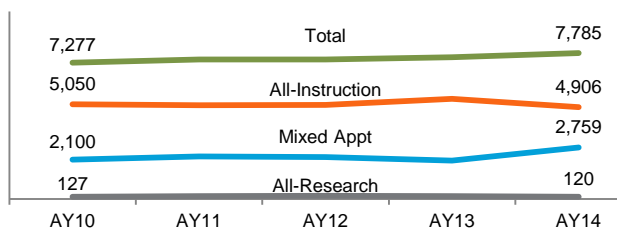

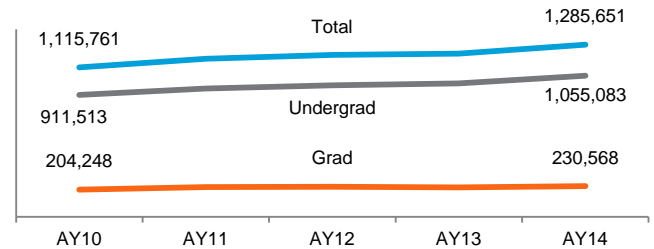
