Approved July 25, 2014

Members of The University of Texas System (UT System) Employee Advisory Council (EAC) shall adhere to the EAC Guidelines as well as the UT System Standards of Conduct as outlined by Chancellor Cigarroa in December 2009. Additionally, members shall:

- Engage in the meeting discussions and committee work
- Get involved and encourage other members to participate in discussions
- Represent your institution and its employees to the best of your ability
- Be respectful while others are speaking
- Engage in active listening
- Commit to communication - share what you learn at the UT System EAC with your campus and share what you learn at your institution with the UT System EAC; Ensure alternate members are well-informed
- Interact respectfully while participating as a member of EAC or representing your institution
- Be accountable to the EAC and the committee on which you serve
  
- Commit to attending meetings in their entirety. Plan arrival and departure to allow for full participation in the meeting.
